# Tentative Shohin Bonsai 2020 Japan International Bonsai Exploration

## Sunday, January 5, 2020 U.S.A./Tokyo

Leave your home city for your flight for your adventure in Japan. You are about to enter a totally foreign culture with traditions thousands of years old. You will cross the International Date line and arrive in Tokyo on the next day.

#### Monday, January 6, 2020 Tokyo

After immigration and customs clearance you will be assisted to your hotel for two nights.

## Tuesday, January 7, 2020 Tokyo/Omiya/Hanyu/Tokyo

Today we will first travel to the private bonsai garden of Masahiko Kimura by private motorcoach. New innovative bonsai as well as classical masterpieces can be seen in his garden. Our final stop for the day is in Hanyu to visit S-Cube Bonsai Garden Uchiku-Tei of Seiji Morimae. His garden has thousands of bonsai for sale as well as containers, antiques and bonsai tables for sale.

#### Wednesday, January 8, 2020 Tokyo/Shizuoka/Kyoto

This morning we will enjoy a private visit to Shunkaen Bonsai Museum of bonsai artist, Kunio Kobayashi. His museum features some of the finest bonsai in the world displayed in traditional Japanese alcoves of many different styles. Several of the top award winning bonsai can be enjoyed as well as an extensive antique container collection. Bonsai tables, suiseki, books and containers are available for sale. In the afternoon we will take the bullet train crossing Japan with views of Mt. Fuji, bamboo forests and tea plantations. We will make a stop at Taisho-en Bonsai Garden of Mr. Urushibata featuring shohin bonsai. Upon arrival in Kyoto we will be transfered to your hotel.

## Thursday, January 9, 2020 Kyoto

Today we have a full day of sightseeing in this serene and historical city including visits to several Japanese gardens. For this special Winter 2020 tour we will be visiting gardens not normally seen in our Autumn Tours. Additionally we will visit Arashiyama, a district on the western outskirts of Kyoto featuring a bamboo forest, monkey mountain and historic temples and gardens. Tenryu-ji, one of the oldest Zen Buddhist temples was founded in 1339 will be explored.
