

Introductory Bonsai Course

This comprehensive **Introductory Bonsai Course** has been planned to teach the fundamentals of classical bonsai art to people who have had no experience in this fascinating living art form. Detailed and thorough information will be explained on the theory and techniques of bonsai design, pruning, wiring and potting. Students will learn the background and skills to create, develop and maintain their own bonsai. Each three hour lesson consists of a Powerpoint program that reveals the beauty of well developed bonsai masterpieces, followed by a demonstration and workshop where students are encouraged and assisted in creating their own bonsai.

Instructor for this special course is **William N. Valavanis**, professional bonsai artist, author and educator. He has combined his two horticultural degrees and fifty year intense bonsai study and passion to develop dynamic educational programs which he freely shares with organizations around the world. He is the publisher and editor of *International BONSAI*, a well recognized magazine distributed around the globe.

The **Introductory Bonsai Course** will be held on five Monday or Wednesday evenings from 7:00 - 10:00 P.M. or on Saturday mornings from 9:00 A.M. to 12:00 P.M.
