

INTRODUCTORY BONSAI COURSE

Autumn 2010



This **Introductory Bonsai Course** has been particularly planned for students who have had no experience in this fascinating living horticultural art form. The aesthetic appreciation and fundamentals of Classical Bonsai Art are taught in the five week course. Major emphasis will be on the theory and techniques of bonsai design, pruning, wiring and potting. Each lesson consists of a slide lecture, demonstration and workshop where students are encouraged and assisted in creating their own bonsai. Five bonsai will be created by each student by the end of the course which are suitable for indoor cultivation. Several tropical species are available for this course.

The **Introductory Bonsai Course** will be held on five Monday or Wednesday evenings from 7:00 to 10:00 PM or five Saturday mornings from 9:00 AM to 12 Noon. All classes will be held at the International Bonsai Arboretum, 1070 Martin Road, West Henrietta, New York. An area map will be sent with confirmation. Bonsai artist and educator William N. Valavanis will be the instructor.
