INTERNATIONAL BONSAI EXPLORATION TO 2017 8TH WBFF BONSAI CONVENTION

Tuesday, April 25, 2017 U.S.A./Tokyo

Leave your home city for your flight for your adventure in Japan. You are about to enter a totally foreign culture with traditions thousands of years old. You will cross the International Date line and arrive at the Narita Airport in Tokyo on the next day.

Wednesday, April 26, 2017 Tokyo/Omiya (Saitama)

After immigration and customs clearance you will be assisted to the convention hotel in Omiya (Saitama) for six nights.



Thursday, April 27, 2017 Saitama/World Bonsai Convention

This morning we will enjoy a private visit to Shunkaen Bonsai Museum of bonsai artist, Kunio Kobayashi. His museum features some of the finest bonsai in the world displayed in traditional Japanese alcoves of many different styles. Numerous of the top award winning bonsai can be enjoyed as well as an extensive antique container collection. Bonsai tables, suiseki, books and containers are available for sale.

After lunch we will attend the Opening Ceremony of the 8th World Bonsai Convention which will be followed by a demonstration by Masahiko Kimura. A reception will conclude today's activities.

Friday, April 28, 2017 Saitama/World Bonsai Convention

Join many others from around the world at the 8th World Bonsai Convention. Taiga Urushibata and an international artist will be on stage with their demonstrations. In the afternoon Hiroshi Takeyama and an international artist will present their bonsai demonstrations. Throughout the four day convention the "Japan Bonsai Suiseki Greatest Exhibition" will be held in the Saitama Super Arena. Over 300 of Japan's highest class bonsai and suiseki masterpieces will be displayed, in addition to other special displays.

An extensive sales area with professionals offering bonsai, tools, containers, display tables and more will be in the same venue.



Saturday, April 29, 2017 Saitama/World Bonsai Convention

Today we return to the 8th World Bonsai Convention. To start the day's demonstrator Chiharu Imai, Kenji Oshima, Masayuki Fujikawa and Shigeo Isobe. International artists will present their bonsai demonstrations.

In the afternoon, following a shohin bonsai demonstration and an international artist, Kunio Kobayashi will demonstrate. A satsuki azalea demonstration follows. A Dinner Party in the evening will offer the opportunity to greet fellow bonsai hobbyists from around the world.

Sunday, April 30, 2017 Saitama/World Bonsai Convention

Visit the 8th World Bonsai Convention. In the morning Minoru Akiyama and Takashi Sakurai will be demonstrating followed by Isao Omachi and Mitsuio Matsuda. International artists will demonstrate in the afternoon followed by a suiseki presentation. Shinji Suzuki's demonstration follows. The "Grand Finale" will conclude the 8th World Bonsai Convention.



Monday, May 1, 2017 Omiya/Hanyu/Omiya

Today we will first travel to the private bonsai garden of Masahiko Kimura by private motorcoach. New innovative bonsai as well as classical masterpieces can be seen in his garden. Afterwards you will explore Omiya Bonsai Village including the newly opened Omiya Bonsai Art Museum featuring bonsai from the famous Takagi Bonsai Collection as well as antique containers and wood block prints. Some of the finest bonsai in the world are created and maintained in Omiya Bonsai Village and you will visit the bonsai gardens of Kato, Takeyama, Yamada and Murata. Our final stop for the day is in Hanyu to visit S-Cube Bonsai Garden Uchiku-Tei of Seiji Morimae. His garden has thousands of bonsai for sale as well as containers, antiques and bonsai tables for sale.

Tuesday, May 2, 2017 Omiya/Obuse/Nagano

After a delightful train ride through the northern part of central Japan we will visit the private bonsai garden of Shinji Suzuiki. This award winning bonsai artist specializes in a wide range of species and is well known for the appreciation of bonsai through the art of display. Following the visit we will stay at a hotel in Obuse or Nagano.



Wednesday, May 3, 2017 Nagano/Kanazawa

Another train ride will lead us through the scenic mountains to Kanazawa. Located in the central part of the mainland of Japan, Kanazawa is the prefectural capital of Ishikawa Prefecture. The southeast area of the city faces the mountains and the northwest area faces the Sea of Japan.

We will visit Kenroku-en, one of the three best landscape style gardens. Originally a private garden, construction began in the 1620s to 1840. Famous for its many varieties of trees, the oldest natural fountain operating by natural water pressure can be enjoyed. Well known pine trees and stone lanterns and bridges can be seen. Historic sights and buildings can be visited once we check into our hotel in Kanazawa.

Thursday, May 4, 2017 Kanazawa/Tokoname

Another train ride will lead us through central Japan with scenic views of the Sea of Japan and mountains. We will stop in Takayama famous for its preserved historic wooden Edo Period buildings and narrow streets. Free time after arrival at our hotel in Tokoname.

Friday, May 5, 2017 Tokoname

We will have an entire day visiting Tokoname, one of the ancient kilns in Japan. The finest bonsai containers are made in Tokoname where you will have the opportunity to see artists hand make bonsai containers and purchase containers at discounted prices.

Saturday, May 6, 2017 Tokoname/U.S.A.

This morning at your leisure. In the afternoon you will be transferred to the Nagoya airport which is in Tokoname, for your flight home. As you cross the International Date Line you will arrive home on the same calendar day.

Saturday, May 6, 2017 Tokoname/Kyoto

Japan's famous bullet train will whisk you to Kyoto, one of the old capitals of Japan. We will have a full day of sightseeing in this serene and historical city including visits to many famous Japanese gardens. Specific gardens cannot be listed, but among the gardens we normally visit are: The Ryoanji Temple, noted for its quiet rock garden, the Golden Pavilion with a pond and exquisite stroll garden up a hill and Daisen-in Temple with rock arrangements. Each of these sites played an important role in the history of this island nation as part of the ancient capitol of Kyoto. Transfer to our hotel.
